NOTICE: CPD YEAR 2020 POINTS REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The following lawyers (including those practising as locum solicitors) will need to fulfil CPD requirements for CPD Year 2020, which runs from 1 January to 31 December 2020:
 - a. Advocates and solicitors of more than 15 years' standing ('Group 3 Lawyers') those admitted to the Singapore Bar on or before 31 December 2004;
 - b. Advocates and solicitors of 5 to 15 years' standing ('Group 2 Lawyers') those admitted to the Singapore Bar between 1 January 2005 and 1 January 2015 (both dates inclusive);
 - c. Advocates and solicitors of less than 5 years' standing ('Group 1 Lawyers') those admitted to the Singapore Bar on or after 2 January 2015; and
 - d. Foreign lawyers registered under section 36B of the Legal Profession Act ('s36B Foreign Lawyers').
- 2. For CPD Year 2020, the CPD Points requirements are as follows:
