NOTICE: CPD YEAR 2024 POINTS REQUIREMENTS

1. The following lawyers (including those practising as locum solicitors) will need to fulfil CPD requirements for CPD Year 2024, which runs from 1 January to 31 December 2024:
 - a. **Advocates and solicitors of more than 15 years’ standing (‘Group 3 Lawyers’)** – those admitted to the Singapore Bar on or before 31 December 2008;
 - b. **Advocates and solicitors of 5 to 15 years’ standing (‘Group 2 Lawyers’)** – those admitted to the Singapore Bar between 1 January 2009 and 1 January 2019 (both dates inclusive);
 - c. **Advocates and solicitors of less than 5 years’ standing (‘Group 1 Lawyers’)** – those admitted to the Singapore Bar on or after 2 January 2019; and
 - d. **Foreign lawyers registered under section 36B of the Legal Profession Act (‘s36B Foreign Lawyers’).**

2. For CPD Year 2024, the CPD Points requirements are as follows:
