## Quick Guide

### When does CPD Year 2025 run?

CPD Year 2025 runs from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025

### How many CPD Points do I need to obtain for CPD Year 2025?

<p><b>Group 1</b></p> <p><b>Lawyers</b></p> <p>(Admitted to the Singapore Bar on or after 2 January 2020)</p> <p>You need to obtain</p> <p><b>16</b></p> <p>CPD Points.</p> <p>At least 8 must be Public CPD Points</p> <p><i>*Up to 8 CPD Points may be from teaching.</i></p>	<p><b>Group 2</b></p> <p><b>Lawyers</b></p> <p>(Admitted to the Singapore Bar between 1 January 2010 and 1 January 2020)</p> <p>You need to obtain</p> <p><b>10</b></p> <p>CPD Points.</p> <p>At least 5 must be Public CPD Points.</p> <p><i>*Up to 5 CPD Points may be from teaching.</i></p>	<p><b>Group 3</b></p> <p><b>Lawyers</b></p> <p>(Admitted to the Singapore Bar on or before 31 December 2009)</p> <p>You need to obtain</p> <p><b>7</b></p> <p>CPD Points.</p> <p>At least 3.5 must be Public CPD Points.</p>	<p><b>s36BFL</b></p> <p>(Foreign lawyers registered under section 36B of the Legal Profession Act)</p> <p>You need to obtain</p> <p><b>10</b></p> <p>CPD Points.</p> <p>At least 5 must be Public CPD Points.</p>

Out of your total required CPD Points, you will need to obtain **3 MEC Points**.  
At least **1.5** of these must be Public MEC Points.

*\*You may have different points requirements if you hold your PC/FPC for less than 8 months during CPD Year 2025, or if you avail of a [deemed waiver](#).*

### How do I obtain CPD Points?

#### Public CPD Points

Attend an **Accredited CPD Activity**

Perform certain roles in the Part A and Part B Courses and the Foreign Practitioner Examinations.

Attend an eligible non-accredited activity.  
Such as a conference, lecture, seminar, or workshop.

Review an eligible multimedia, Internet-based, audio-visual, audio or video programme or material.

Attend an in-house seminar conducted for lawyers.

#### MEC Points

##### Public MEC Points:

Attend an Accredited CPD Activity which carries MEC Points.  
See [CALAS](#) for a full list of Accredited CPD Activities and use the MEC filter to search for activities with MEC Points.

##### Private MEC Points:

Undertake an eligible non-accredited activity on ethics and professional standards.  
Such as watching a video or attending an in-house seminar on ethics and professional standards.

*You can obtain MEC Points from activities which cover both MEC and non-MEC content. Example: During a 2-hour seminar on family law, there is a 30-minute segment on ethical obligations of lawyers in family law matters. You may obtain 2 CPD Points, of which 0.5 CPD Points are MEC Points.*
