Accredited CPD Activities

Attending a conference, lecture, seminar or workshop accredited by the Singapore Institute of Legal Education. Visit www.silecpdcentre.sg/calas/ for a listing.

Part A and B Bar Courses

Teaching in, or being appointed as subject coordinator, facilitator or other roles in the Part A and Part B Bar Courses.

Foreign Practitioner Examinations

Being a Chief or Principal Examiner for the Foreign Practitioner Examinations.

Online Learning

Reviewing a multimedia, Internet-based, audio-visual, audio or video programme or material.

Non-accredited CPD Activities

Attending a non-accredited conference, lecture, seminar or workshop on:

- Practice of law
- Financial literacy
- Information technology and computer literacy
- Office productivity and management skills
- Presentation and communication skills
- Personal management
- Any specialist knowledge relevant to your practice needs

Small Group Discussion

Attending a small group discussion organised by or for a group of lawyers or law practices.

In-house Seminar

Attending an in-house seminar conducted by a law practice for its own lawyers.

Writing a Legal Article

Writing an article relating to the practice of law that is published in an Approved Publication.

Approved Committee Work

Serving as a member of any approved committee of the Law Society of Singapore, the Singapore Academy of Law and the Singapore Institute of Legal Education.

Pro Bono Programme

Participating in the Pro Bono Programme for Law Students as a supervisor to law students.

CPD Points by Teaching

Speaking, teaching or participating in a panel discussion in any accredited or non-accredited CPD activity which deals with the practice of law.
